her first piece, Citizen Kane, was a huge canvas on the theme film noir she was very daunted scared she wasn't yet an artist she just had potential her tutor saw her fears and listened to her concerns he showed her what was possible if she followed their instructions made especially for her she needed to use the light box to sketch each shade from the photograph they had made it into greyscale she was to work out 5 colours with 1 being the whitest white to 5 being blackest black she sketched them out using the light shining through the paper onto 5 pieces of tracing paper he then photographed these onto acetates she was shown how to paint a stretched canvas using a large brush and white primer the next week she drew a border in pencil and painted her mid colour grey number 3 inside left it to dry then fixed it to an easel in front of an overhead projector and sketched colour number 2 she mixed the grey and painted it repeating this process until she had a complete painting her first success story
